Sights around the Tokachigawa Hot Spring

The area around Tokachigawa Hot Spring offers a number of attractions other than the spring itself. Why not take a drive around and see the local sights after a relaxing bath? The scenery may look a whole lot different when your body and mind are refreshed.

Tokachigaoka Park (Hanack)

The park features a vast lawn and fun wooden playground equipment. At its center is a huge flower clock called "Hanack." Its face is 18 m in diameter, and its second hand is 10.10 m long. For souvenirs and delicious soft-serve ice cream, come to the Welcome Hanack concession stand. Also with an outdoor cooking area and a multipurpose square, it is a park that makes the most of Tokachi's distinctive magnificence.



Tokachigaoka Scenic Viewpoint

This overlook is just up the hill from Tokachigaoka Park. It commands a view of the slowly flowing Tokachi River, Tokachigawa hot spring resort, the vast Tokachi Plains and the faraway Hidaka Mountains.

It's an ideal spot to enjoy lovely sunsets.



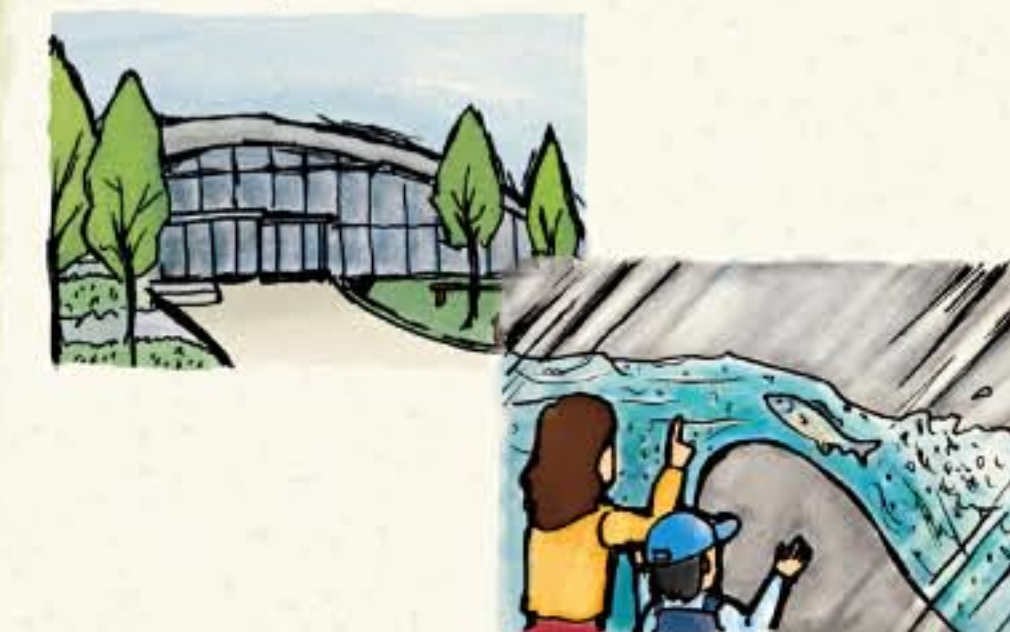
Aqua Park (a stopover of swans)

Many swans arrive between early November and early May at the Tokachi River just south of the Tokachigawa hot spring resort. Mallards and other waterfowl also rest their wings here. These birds, the "diamond dust" natural phenomenon and other fantastic winter features of the riverside make for most impressive views.



Hokkaido Tokachi Ecology Park

Tokachi Ecology Park is a park for environmental education that allows visitors to enjoy, learn about and encounter the natural splendor of Tokachi. Red-crowned cranes, Steller's sea eagles, white-tailed sea eagles and other rare wild birds have recently been spotted in the park. Salmon and other fish that swim through the stepped fishway can also be viewed from the adjoining fishway observation room.



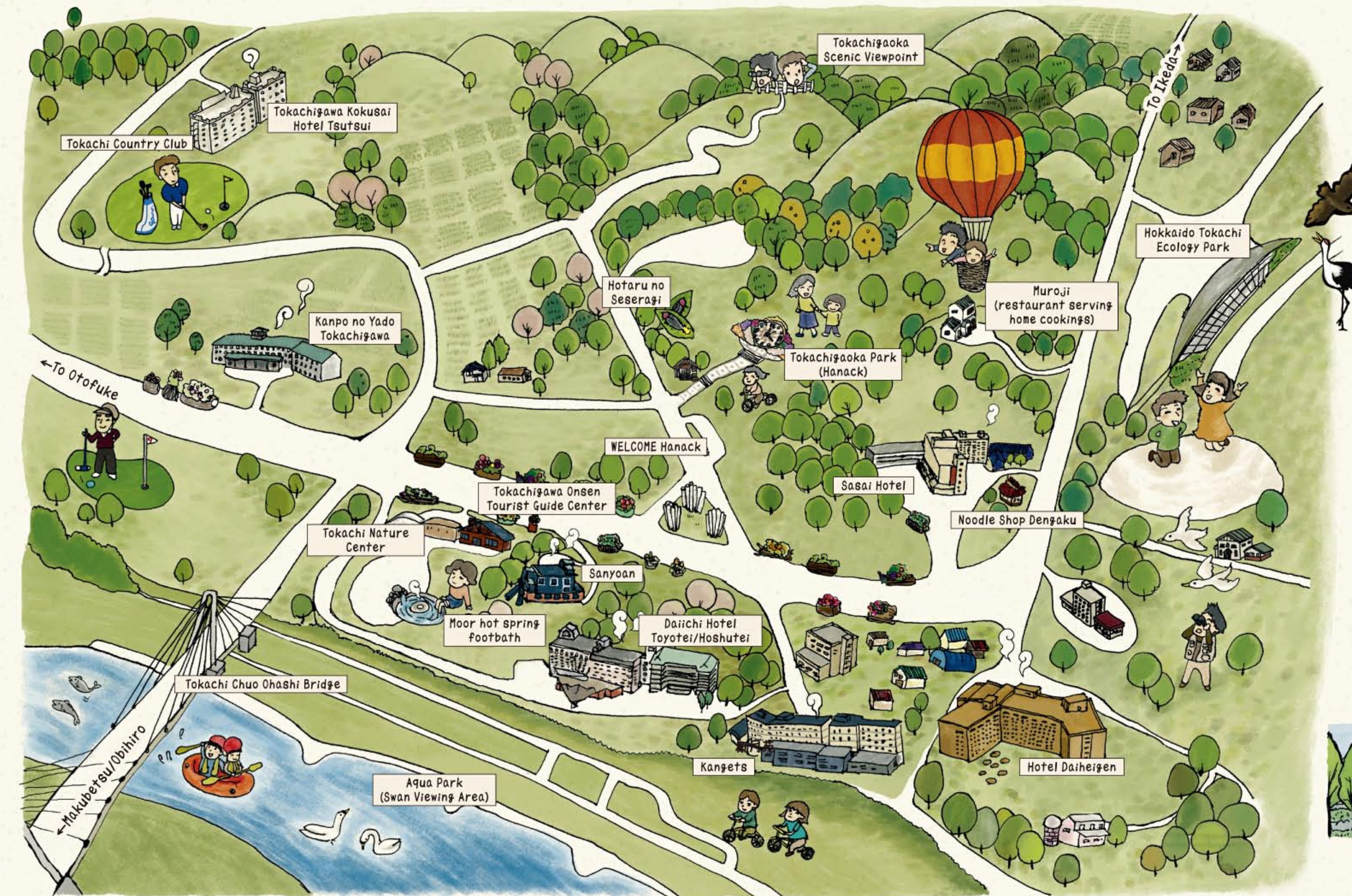
Tokachigawa Onsen Tourist Guide Center
